Exchange of Information.

1. The decision by Dorset Council to cease sending neighbour letters advising residents of planning applications was discussed. The concern is so great that

members requested this subject be discussed at the next Full Council meeting. The clerk will add to the agenda for the Full Council Discussion Group to be held on Wed 28th July 2021.

2. A request has been received from a resident asking if the committee could routinely assess if TPOs should be placed on trees before planning applications are considered and granted. TPOs are considered by the planners as part of any planning application. However, once a planning application is granted that permission overrides any TPOs in place on the site.
