TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHERRY TREE CLOSE, ST LEONARDS & ST IVES

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Cherry Tree Close, St Leonards & St Ives from the junction with Oaks Drive (in both directions), a distance of approximately 140 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 21st July 2021 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27th July 2021. The road will be reopened at the weekend.

This Notice will enable South West Water safe access to repair a leaking communication pipe.

There will be no alternative route on this occasion, however access will be maintained for emergency services and residents.
