

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BOUNDARY LANE, SAINT LEONARDS & ST IVES

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Boundary Lane, Saint Leonards 200 meters from both directions from the junction of Foxbury Road, a distance of approximately 400 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

The Notice comes in to operation on 16th August 2021 between 09:30 and 15:30 and will remain in force for 5 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18th August 2021

This Notice will enable BT safe access to carry out and work on underground structure and overhead cables in the highway.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Boundary Lane - A31 - Hurn Road - Boundary Lane
