

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BOUNDARY LANE, ST LEONARDS & ST IVES

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Boundary Lane, St Leonards & St Ives from the junction with Grange Road to 230 metres to the east of Foxbury Road (in both directions), a distance of approximately 530 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 09:30 until 15:30 on 6th October 2021 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8th October 2021.

This Notice will enable Openreach to install overhead and underground fibre cabling.

The alternative vehicular route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Boundary Lane, A31, Hurn Road vice versa.
