

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF B3081 VERWOOD ROAD, ST LEONARDS AND ST IVES

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along B3081 Verwood Road from the entrance of Watchmoor Car Park (in both directions) a distance of approximately 525 metres from this point north. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 25th October 2021 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 29th October 2021.

**This Notice will enable Dorset Council safe access to carry out and fell trees, remedial works in the highway.**

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: B3081 - HORTON ROAD - RINGWOOD ROAD - VERWOOD ROAD B3072 - STATION ROAD - RINGWOOD
