

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, ST LEONARDS AND ST IVES

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Various Roads, St Leonards and St Ives as described below. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation between 07:30 - 16:00 on 24th February 2024 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 4th March 2024.

**This Order will enable Kiely Bros Ltd to carry out carriageway surface treatment works.**

The effect of this Order is as follows:

- [1] To impose temporary road closure of Norris Close, St Leonards and St Ives as indicated by signs on site.
- [2] To impose temporary road closure of Bushmead Drive, St Leonards and St Ives as indicated by signs on site.
- [3] To impose temporary road closure of Woolsbridge Road, St Leonards and St Ives as indicated by signs on site.
- [4] To impose temporary road closure of Badgers Close, St Leonards and St Ives as indicated by signs on site.
- [5] To impose temporary road closure of Windsor Close, St Leonards and St Ives as indicated by signs on site.
