

URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BOUNDARY LANE, ST LEONARDS AND ST IVES

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Boundary Lane, St Leonards and St Ives between 41 Boundary Lane and Wayside Road. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 22nd April 2024 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 26th April 2024. Residents access will be maintained.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out urgent works to install over pumping due to a collapsed sewer.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
