

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF A338 SPUR ROAD, ASHLEY HEATH

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along A338 Spur Road, Ashley Heath as indicated by signs on site. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 13th October 2025 between 21:00 and 06:00 and remain in force for five days, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17th October 2025. A southbound closure will be in place overnight on 13th October 2025 and 14th October 2025, with a northbound closure following overnight on 15th October 2025 and 16th October 2025, to be clear by 6am on 17th October 2025.

This Notice will enable Dorset Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and gully clearing works.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
